HOW STUDENTS COMPETE



FALL | SELECT

Students choose from four competitive event categories: Dragster Design, Fashion Design and Technology, Technology Problem Solving and VEX Robotics.



WINTER | PRACTICE

Using skills learned in the classroom, students prepare for competition by studying, preparing their materials, practicing, and sometimes competing at the region level.



SPRING | COMPETE

Students advancing to state competition will put their skills to the test at the SLC. As a judge, you will meet TSA's best and brightest members as they present the projects they have been working on all year.



SUMMER | SHOWCASE

Oregon's top winners will head to National TSA Conference to compete for a winning spot on the International stage.
