WHAT IS THE PRESIDENT'S COUNCIL?

The President's Council is a representation of leaders from TSA Chapters across the state.

WHY HAS IT BEEN ESTABLISHED?

The council has been established because of the growth that has taken place in the 2023-2024 school year and the expected growth that will continue. In order to engage and sustain the level of quality programs TSA is known for, representation is wanted and needed from every TSA Chapter; we want every chapter's voice to be heard and ideas to be expressed and valued. Our goal is to develop 100X leaders in every chapter across the state.

WHO WILL THE COUNCIL CONSIST OF?

One Chapter Officer will be recommended by each Chapter's Advisor to sit on the council. Chapter President or another appointed officer/member in good standing may serve.

WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS OF INVOLVEMENT?

- Oregon TSA President's Council polo.
- Volunteer Service Certificate upon conclusion of the term.
- Receive leadership (Five Voices) and CTSO organizational training through Oregon TSA's Coaching Program.
- Participate in and have a lead role in the State Leadership Conference and other state hosted events.
- Receive complimentary registration to the State Leadership Conference.
- State President and State Vice President will be chosen from the Council; additional benefits and responsibilities will be involved in these two roles.

WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS/COMMITMENT?

- Attend 2 (two) virtual meetings per month (President and Vice President will meet one additional time per month); must attend a total of 12 meetings throughout their term.
- Term will be conclusion of State Leadership Conference one year to the next.
- Attend all state hosted/endorsed events: Virtual Kick-Off Event, State Leadership Conference, Virtual Technology Bowl Challenge.
- Additional opportunities at a discounted rate: Fall Retreat/Advisor Conference and Fall Leadership Conference.
- Facilitate development of Chapter's Program of Work and report on progress at monthly meetings. Training will be provided on Program of Work creation.
- Participate in development and execution of Oregon TSA's Program of Work.

- Serve in the role of a Chapter Officer and/or member in good standing.
- Be recommended for President's Council by Chapter Advisor.
- Sign agreement to responsibilities of serving on the President's Council.
